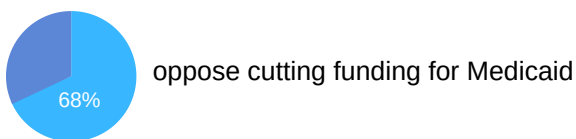
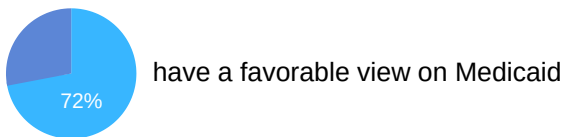
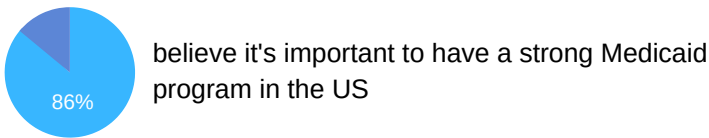

West Virginia Medicaid Matters

West Virginia Medicaid covers more than 590,000 members, and of that, 81% are enrolled in managed care. The three managed care organizations in West Virginia (Aetna, The Health Plan and UniCare) provide coverage for members with disabilities (SSI), members who fall under the expansion, temporary assistance for needy families (TANF), and the Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP). The enrollment numbers and percentages are provided in more detail under the **WV Medicaid Highlights**.

In a survey done by the [Modern Medicaid Alliance](#), West Virginians, by and large, support the Medicaid program:



33% of West Virginia's population is covered by Medicaid. It's evident this program is important to the people in our state, and the MCOs are committed to providing affordable high quality healthcare coverage to all members.
