Snapshot of WV Health Insurance Plans

Earlier this month AHIP, America's Health Insurance Plans, published a report outlining the impact health plans have on their respective state. The data included information on types of coverage, jobs generated, tax revenue paid to support the local economy, and more.

West Virginia numbers at a glance:

- 45% private insurance
- · 26% Medicaid
- · 20% Medicare
- 7% Uninsured
- 3% other
- health plan employees 1,520
- payroll for health plan employees \$92,477,000
- average salary for health plan employees \$60,840
- \$118,061,000 in state premium tax collected

*It's important to note, PEIA was not included in AHIP's findings and CHIP numbers are counted under Medicaid.

The report highlights that West Virginia's health insurance plans not only provide coverage to more than 1.3 million residents but are a major contributor to the work force and financial support of our communities and state.
