MCOs Awarded Contracts

The managed care organizations of West Virginia were awarded contracts by the WV DHHR to continue managing the state's Medicaid program. The new three year contract becomes effective on July 1, 2020. After a comprehensive and competitive bidding process by the state's purchasing division, Aetna Better Health of WV, The Health Plan and UniCare Health Plan of WV were selected to continue healthcare services to our state's Medicaid population. MCOs were required to meet various measures including financial health, operational needs and adequate network of providers. Ben Beakes, the Executive Director of WVAHP says, "Each of these MCOs has demonstrated a strong record of managing quality care and efficient services to West Virginia Medicaid members." The plan presidents, Todd White (Aetna), Jason Landers (The Health Plan) and Tadd Haynes (UniCare) understand the unique needs and challenges that many of their members face. They are committed to improving the lives and offering quality health care across all 55 counties. With a combined 64 years of service to our state, the MCOs are eager to continue their work here.
