## **Medicaid Managed Care Survey Results**

In 2018, the Institute for Medicaid Innovation published the results from a survey they conducted on Medicaid access and coverage of care. The report is intended to provide an accurate description of how managed care operates nationwide.

The MCOs that participated in the survey provide coverage to more than 20 million members, or 44.4%, across 34 states. Important topics within the Medicaid program that are found in this report are: high risk care coordination, value based payment, pharmacy, women's health, behavioral health, child & adolescent health and long term services & support.

Two notable topics to mention from this report are who MCOs serve and how that service is provided. Across the board, the largest population that MCOs care for are children and that includes those in foster care and those with special needs. Their coordination of care is a team approach: care coordinator from health plan, individual member, behavioral specialist, and family members. This team approach is one way how MCOs offer quality health care to their members.

The evidence and data found in this report provides a detailed explanation of the value MCOs bring to the table- not only in WV but across the country.
