WVAHP Donates \$20,000 to WV Health Right

The managed care organizations of WV attended the ribbon cutting ceremony on June 1st to show their support of the efforts being in the local community. Ben Beakes, the Executive Director of WVAHP said this, "Partnering with high-impact organizations like WV Health Right will expand quality care to some of the most vulnerable populations of the state." Over the last year the MCOs have seen an increase in enrollment, so expansions like this will help to assist those in the Medicaid program.
